The Risen Savior Parent Resources

Title: Jesus Enters Jerusalem as King Passage: Matthew 21–23; Zechariah 9:9 Principle: Jesus is the promised Messiah. Praise: "King of Kings"

Prompt: Ask your child these questions:

- What did Jesus ride into Jerusalem?
- How did the crowds treat Jesus as the promised King?
- What did Jesus do in the temple?
- Why was Jesus angry with the temple priests?

Practice: Help your child apply these truths in the following ways:

- By obeying Jesus as King.
- By worshiping Jesus as Lord.
- By telling others about the Messiah.

This Week: As a family, read Matthew 21–23; Zechariah 9:9. **Next Week:** Matthew 26:1–19, 36–50

Title: Judas Betrays Jesus Passage: Matthew 26:1–19, 36–50 Principle: People deny or betray Jesus with sinful attitudes and actions. Praise: "Lord, I Lift Your Name on High" Prompt: Ask your child these questions:

- Who did and did not reject Jesus?
- How did Judas betray Jesus?
- What did the disciples do in the Garden of Gethsemane?
- What had Jesus asked them to do?
- Why was Jesus sad in the Garden of Gethsemane?

Practice: Help your child apply these truths in the following ways:

- By showing that he loves Jesus by obeying Him.
- By remembering that sin is a rejection of Jesus.
- By thanking Jesus for being faithful even when people reject Him.

This Week: As a family, read Matthew 26:1–19, 36–50. **Next Week:** Matthew 27

Title: Jesus Endures the Cross
Passage: Matthew 27
Principle: Jesus died for sin, giving access to God.
Praise: "Jesus Paid It All"
Prompt: Ask your child these questions:

Who mocked Jesus?

- What did the soldiers do to Jesus?
- What did the soluters doHow did lesus die?
- What happened when Jesus died?
- Why did Jesus die?

Practice: Help your child apply these truths in the following ways:

- By praising Jesus for suffering and dying for sin.
- By trusting Jesus for forgiveness of sin.
- By thanking Jesus for allowing us to come to God.

This Week: As a family, read Matthew 27. Next Week: Matthew 28

Title: Jesus Rises from the Dead Passage: Matthew 28 Principle: Jesus has power over sin and death. Praise: "Christ the Lord Is Risen Today" Prompt: Ask your child these questions.

- Who appeared to Mary and Mary when they arrived at Jesus' tomb?
- Whom did Jesus appear to after His resurrection?
- What did Jesus tell His disciples?

Practice: Help your child apply these truths in the following ways:

- By obeying Jesus as Savior and Lord.
- By singing praise to the risen Savior.
- By telling others about Jesus' death and resurrection.

This Week: As a family, read Matthew 28.
