MODULE 2 - START THE CLIMB Biblical Theology & Systematic Theology

Study and do your best, make every effort to present yourself to God as a tried-and-true worker, who has no reason to be ashamed but is one who interprets & teaches the Word of Truth correctly. 2 Timothy 2:15

Jesus instructs the church to go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them and teaching them all that he has commanded. In Module One, we learned how to properly interpret the Scriptures so that we can be certain we are actually teaching what Jesus has commanded instead of replacing the meaning of his words with our own ideas. In Module Two, we will utilize these interpretative principles to see what the Bible teaches on a variety of theological topics, especially as they relate to the discipleship process. If we are to teach *ALL* that Jesus has commanded, we need an organized, intentional approach to knowing what the Bible says about all aspects of life. Theologians recognize two methods for doing this: Biblical Theology & Systematic Theology.
