The following guide gives you an overview of our planned response depending on the situation status.

If you or family members have any symptoms of illness we would ask you to stay home and watch the Sunday morning service on Livestream. We would also ask that anyone who is considered high-risk to please stay home and watch the service on Livestream. Level 3	Confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Tehachapi OR Public mandate for all churches to stop public gatherings	 Limit Sunday services to online only Cancel all midweek gatherings Church office will remain open
Level 4	Confirmed case of COVID-19 at Country Oaks Baptist Church	 Limit Sunday services to online only Cancel all midweek gatherings Church office will be closed Follow CDC recommendations for deep-cleaning facilties

According to the Center for Disease control, an individual is considered high-risk if they an older adult or if they have serious chronic medical conditions, such as heart disease, diabetes, or lung disease.
